Get your own Domain name like ILove-MyRV.com. Your email can then be chris@ILoveMyRV.com, and it won't matter what service you use to get Internet access. AOL charging too much? Switch to Juno. Juno doesn't have access numbers where you're going? Switch to Earthlink. Maybe you're really lucky and the RV park you're staying in has high-speed wireless access. You don't want to use that and still have to pay for AOL too! Through all these changes, your email will stay chris@ILoveMyRV.com.

It is an easy matter to get your own Domain and then your own email address. Once you own the Domain "ILoveMyRV.com" you can put up your own personal website. No more emailing dozens of photos to dozens of people, just post them to your website and tell all your friends and family to go to www.ILoveMyRV.com to see what's going on.
